Industrialisation and the People - In this unit students will examine a pinnacle period of British History, as the country transformed from an agricultural, unrepresentative nation to the beginnings of the country we recognise now. The unit will explore the transformation of democracy, society, economy and the role that key individuals played in that transformation.

History



The Cold War - This unit examines the evolving course of international relations during an era of tension between communist and capitalist powers which threatened nuclear Armageddon. It examines the role that key leaders played in escalating and calming tensions, whilst also examining the role the Cold War played across the globe. The unit should encourage students to examine the role ideology plays in confrontation but also what factors are necessary for peace and cooperation.



NEA Coursework - The NEA requires students to write a 350-4500 word essay on a historical topic/time period spanning 100 years. It utilises the skills learnt through the exam topics, and encourages students to engage with historians' interpretations and primary sources to reach a conclusion on the topic.
