You will develop an understanding of legal method and reasoning as used by lawyers and the judiciary and apply these techniques to analyse and offer answers to problems, based on legal principles, legislation and case law. Through the study of criminal, tort and human rights law you will develop the ability to construct conclusions and communicate legal arguments by reference to appropriate legal authorities. You will study the influence and operation of the law in society and develop a critical awareness of the law.

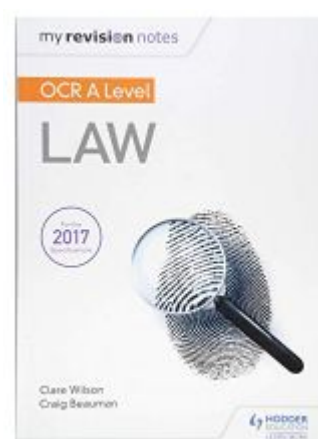
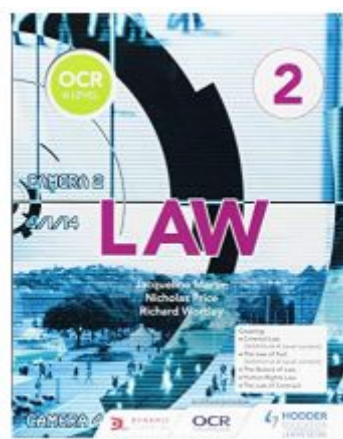
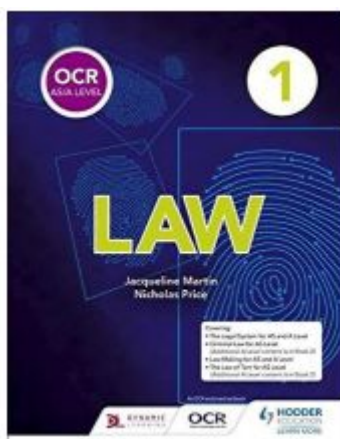
